født d. 5. Feb. 1851 i Foulou Sogn, Danmark. Han med sin Hustru og deres Søn, Anders kom til Amerika 9 Juni 1880, og saa vidt jeg ved kom de lige til West Denmark, hvor Møller har levet hele Tiden. Han hører altsaa med til Pionererne her. Han var paa mange Maader en Foregangsmand, sandru og redelig i sin Færd. Særlig var han, indtil for nogle Aar siden, en aktiv Medlem af Menigheden; men da var der noget, der skete til ham, som jeg ikke her, hverken skal ej Lettes kan give Rede for; men som gjorde, at han trak sig tilbage fra Menighedsarbejdet.

Han døde d. 21 Feb. efter faa Ugers Sygdom, her i sit Hjem. Han blev plejet og passet til det sidste med Kærlighed og Ønsker af hans Datter Ane Mette-Han blev sted til Hvil paa W. D. Kirkegaard d. 25 Feb.

Born Feb. 5th. 1851 in Fovlum parish, Denmark. He with his wife and their son, Anders came to America June 9th. 1880, and as I know, they came direct to West Denmark, where Møller has been living alle the time. He belongs also to the pioneers here. He was in many ways a pioneer, honest in his actions. In particular, he was, until a few years ago, an active member of the congregation; but then there was something that happened to him, which I can neither here nor easily explain; but which caused him to withdraw from church work.

He died on 21 Feb. after a few weeks illness, here in his home. He was cared for and taken care of until the end with love and wishes of his daughter Ane Mette-He was laid to rest in the W. D. cemetery on 25 February.

Surviving are 7 children: Anders and Ane Mette in West Denmark; Johannes in Milltown, Aage in Solvang; Karl, Neils and Dagmar in Askov, as well as 13 Grandchildren and 6 Grandchildren's children.
